Continuing Our Faith, Now and Forever



It is the mission of the Catholic Foundation of Southwestern Indiana to assist individuals and parishes with planned giving within the Diocese of Evansville. Each of these continues to make a strong statement about their faith as the gifts they make will benefit others forever. They are truly continuing their legacy of faith through permanent gifts. The role of the Catholic Foundation is to ensure that we are managing, protecting and honoring the wishes of these donors.

During 2007, the Catholic Foundation of Southwestern Indiana realized record growth with the establishment of 29 new endowments and new gifts of over \$2.7 million. Included in these new endowments were eight endowments established to assist students attending Catholic elementary schools, two new endowments created for catechist programs at parishes, and four new endowments to support the Evansville Catholic Interparochial High Schools.

Several endowments have been established through the years to help with the needs of the poor in our communities, such as Catholic Charities, Knights of Columbus, St. Vincent de Paul Societies, Global Social Justice, St. Mary Food Pantry and Outreach programs at several parishes. One such endowment is the *St. John Conference of St. Vincent de Paul* at St. John in Loogootee. The endowment was originally established as the result of a bequest in 1996 for the relief of the poor, the distressed, and the underprivileged in and around Martin County. Gifts of all amounts continue to be made to this endowment. Each year, the annual distribution from this endowment is supporting the Food Pantry and Habitat for Humanity, and providing assistance for students to attend school, youth, and educational programs all aimed at alleviating poverty. This one endowment in Martin County has helped thousands experience the love of Christ.

Through commitment and faith, donors are making sure that the ministries that are important to them continue in their parishes, schools, and other organizations. The 277 endowments that have been established during the years and the hundreds of gifts to existing endowments will continue this gift of faith forever.



In our initial Annual Report last year, we reflected upon the many things we had reason to celebrate in the 15th year of the Foundation, including 2006 being a record-smashing year with a number of "firsts" and that the Foundation's assets stood at nearly \$18.5 million at the end of 2006,

an increase of 20% since the end of 2005.

During 2007 *your* Foundation continued to grow in both financial resources entrusted to the oversight of the Board of Directors and in the number of endowments established to support parishes, schools and other important ministries in our diocese.

At December 31, 2007, Foundation assets had a market value over \$22.7 million, an incredible increase of over 23% in one short year. The number of endowments had grown to 277, or nearly 12%, in that twelve month period.

In addition to providing a permanent means of sustaining parish and other needs, as a result of the strong financial performance in 2007, the Foundation made available over \$1 million in early 2008 for distribution to the benefactor parishes, schools and other great causes established by generous members of our diocese over the years.

On behalf of your highly capable Board of Directors and the professional and dedicated staff, we thank you for your confidence in the Foundation. We continue to believe that the Foundation offers significant advantages for parishes and other agencies, including the benefit of highly professional investment management; pooling of funds for greater investment diversification and returns; documentation accountability for every dollar invested, earned and distributed; avoidance of duplicate legal and accounting costs; and assured follow-up with donor representatives. It is indeed inspiring that more and more parishes and individuals are recognizing those advantages as well.
