It is the mission of the Catholic Foundation of Southwestern Indiana to assist individuals and parishes with planned giving within the Diocese of Evansville. The role of the Catholic Foundation is to ensure that we are managing, protecting and honoring the wishes of these donors. Each of these donors are taking steps to preserve their faith by creating legacies that annually give back to the parishes, specific ministries and schools that have played such an important role in their lives.

During 2008, the Catholic Foundation of Southwestern Indiana realized continued growth with the addition of 8 Charitable Gift Annuities, the establishment of 26 new endowments and new gifts of over \$1.6 million. Included in these new endowments were: six endowments established to assist students attending Catholic schools, three endowments created for Social Outreach programs, and six endowments to support parishes that have never had an endowment.

Many parishes have numerous endowments to recognize families and to support individual concerns. One parish decided to establish one endowment to help with any need at the parish and/or school. Precious Blood in Jasper originally established this endowment in 1992 with the minimum amount of \$5,000. Father Kane and several members of the parish wanted to ensure that this one endowment would benefit all parishioners in one way or another. They also wanted each family to have a part in raising the funds and a pride in the accomplishment of reaching this goal. Each family was asked to participate and each gift was appreciated for the treasure it represented. The parish had a goal of \$1 million and decided not to take a distribution until that goal had been met. Today, the endowment generates income that exceeds the income from their largest annual fundraiser. Their annual distribution assists with general and unexpected expenses that may arise. Each year, parishioners continue to remember the endowment in their regular and memorial giving. Last year, a donor made a challenge to the parish to increase the endowment with the goal of keeping tuition affordable. That challenge and their community of donors have continued to raise the awareness and support that will forever preserve the faith at Precious Blood.

The 303 endowments that have been established during the years and the hundreds of gifts to existing endowments will make a difference in the lives of so many for generations to follow. Thank you to each of these donors who continue to pass on the traditions of our faith.
